Engine

All original engine components must be maintained without modifications.

It is allowed to change the intake air filter.

The exhaust system from the output of the turbo compressor is free.

The OEM fuel supply system and all its components must be maintained.

Intercooler replacement is allowed.

Is not allowed remove any component of conditioned air

Engine Electronics

It is allowed to reprogram the parameters of the ECU (engine control unit).

It is free to program the ECU with or without external and/or additional modules.

it is allowed to install accelerator pedal module

Suspension

It is allowed to install camber plates.

It is allowed to replace shock absorbers and suspension springs for Coilover kits.

It is allowed to replace suspension wishbones with other materials as they are identical to OEMs It is allowed

it is allowed to vary the height of the stabilizer bar rods

The height is free.

Brake system

It is allowed to disconnect the ABS System Brake hoses are allowed to be replaced by steel-woven hoses.

It is allowed to replace the brake discs with discs of maximum 335 mm diameter.

It is allowed to change the brake calipers for others with a maximum 4 pistons.



Cooling of the brakes is free.

Brake system fluid is free.

The friction material of the brake pads is free.

Transmission

It is not allowed to change the gear ratio.
It is allowed to install a differential. block system
If the car has an automatic transmission, it is
allowed to install an additional cooling system.

Tires and wheel rims

The maximum measures of the wheels are:

Diameter: 17 inches Width: 7.5 inches

Tread wear can't be lower than 40

The tires must feature the safety certification DOT (USA) and/or NOM (MEXICO).

The use of wheel spacers is allowed.

The installation of studs is allowed to replace wheel bolts.

Electric system

It must be kept original including all its components (alternator, pulleys, etc)

It is allowed to freely relocate the battery.

Weight

The minimum car weight without passengers and without the elements that are not part of the car and that are not fixed to the car weighed at any time during the event is 1200 Kg.

Body and Interior

All OEM components of the body including the hood, front fenders, front and rear bumpers, side doors, sides, rear door, roof, windshield, door windows, side windows and rear windshield must be kept.

it is allowed tue use of John Cooper Works body kit

It is allowed to remove all the components from the interior of the car including door covers, loudspeakers, headliner, etc., and replace them with other components of different material including fiberglass, aluminum, plastic, etc.

The installation of a wing or rear spoiler is allowed. The installation of an engine skid is allowed.

It is allowed to modify the lower part to install supports of external towers type rally
It is allowed to install a navigation system
It is allowed to install a monitoring engine system
